The 2023 SCTC Working Group Research Grants

The purpose of the 2023 SCTC Working Group Research Grants is to provide support for projects that advance the mission of the SCTC and particularly to enhance the productivity of established or new Working Groups.

Applicants must be from SCTC member institutions whose membership is current and in good standing at the time of application. A maximum of four awards of up to \$25,000 (USD) for one-year are anticipated. We will consider continued funding for past awardees based on merit and depending on availability of funds.

Each funded Working Group is expected to present updates at the SCTC Annual General Meeting during the American College of Rheumatology Convergence and at future virtual Collective Working Group Update meetings. The deadline for receipt of the application is midnight (U.S. Eastern Time) on June 1, 2023.

SCTC Industry Roundtable (Spring Meeting) 2023

Our SCTC Spring Industry Roundtable Meeting was held on Friday, March 17th, 2023, in Philadelphia, PA, both virtually and in person and reunited members of the executive committee with industry partners.

The focus of the discussion was on interstitial lung disease (ILD), a pressing issue for patients with systemic sclerosis (SSc). We explored cohort enrichment strategies for therapeutic trials of SSc-ILD necessary to identify and recruit the right patient population for clinical trials. We also discussed risk factors for progression of ILD, essential in predicting disease progression and designing effective treatment strategies. Finally, we reviewed SSc-ILD trial endpoints, which are critical to measure the effectiveness of treatments and advance our understanding of the disease.

The insights and knowledge shared during the meeting were invaluable, and we are grateful to everyone who contributed to the discussion.
